
## ACUMEN ESG Protection Portfolio Share Class A GBP (ISIN: IE00BKBNVB56)

The ACUMEN ESG Protection Portfolio (the "Fund") is a sub-fund of FundLogic Alternatives Plc (the "Company").

### OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

- The Fund's investment objective is to provide investors (i) with long term capital growth from a multi-asset portfolio whilst taking account of its environmental, social and governance policy (the "ESG Investment Policy") and (ii) to deliver a level of capital protection determined by reference to 90% of the highest net asset value ("NAV") per share ever achieved by the Class A GBP Share Class (the "Protection Level").
- The Protection Level is achieved by the Fund (i) through exposure to financial derivative instruments ("FDI") and (ii) an undertaking from Morgan Stanley & Co. International plc or Morgan Stanley Europe SE to ensure investors receive an amount at least equal to the Protection Level upon redemption.
- The investment policy of the Fund, which is actively managed, is to gain exposure to a diverse range of assets including fixed income securities (e.g. an investment security that pays investors an interest rate), equities, currencies (the "Investment Portfolio"), and cash. The Fund will obtain exposure to such securities predominantly through UCITS ETFs and UCITS eligible indices (the "ESG Investment Components") determined from time to time by Tavistock Wealth Limited (the "Sub-Investment Manager").
- More of the Fund's assets will be allocated to cash when markets are volatile with the aim of maintaining the annualised volatility (upwards and downwards fluctuation) of the Fund's underlying strategy between 5% and 7%.
- The ESG Investment Policy seeks to ensure that (i) the ESG Investment Components in aggregate exceed a specific ESG score, and (ii) each ESG Investment Component meets a specific ESG criteria, depending on the nature of the underlying securities, each calculated using an ESG scoring methodology provided by MSCI. The MSCI ESG ratings methodology is a methodology developed by MSCI in order to attribute a ESG rating to a fund or an index, measuring specifically the Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) characteristics of portfolio holdings. - In addition, certain ESG Investment Components are negatively screened (based on data provided by MSCI) for their involvement in the following sectors: Adult Entertainment, Alcohol, Civilian Firearms, Conventional Military Weapons, Gambling, Genetically Modified Organisms, Nuclear Power and Tobacco.
- The cost of the protection means your return will be lower than for an equivalent fund without protection in a market that has risen or remained flat.
- Any income from the Fund will be re-invested and the Fund will not pay out any dividends
- The Fund is suitable for investors who are seeking capital growth over a medium to long term horizon.
- The value of the Fund is calculated and published daily except as set out in the Company's prospectus and the Fund's supplement (collectively "Prospectus"). Investors can buy and/or sell back their shares daily.
- The investment manager of the Fund is FundLogic SAS, a French management company authorised by the French regulator, the Autorité des Marchés Financiers, and it has appointed Tavistock Wealth Limited as Sub-Investment Manager of the Fund.

### RISK AND REWARD PROFILE

#### Other risks that you should be aware of, which may not be captured by the Risk and Reward Indicator, include:

- The Fund's performance is dependent on factors other than the Investment Portfolio's performance. Thus investors will not be able to derive the NAV of the Fund directly from changes in the level of the Investment Portfolio alone.
- The Sub-Investment Manager manages the Investment Portfolio and so the success of the Fund depends, among other things, upon the expertise of the Sub-Investment Manager.
- As the Fund incorporates ESG criteria into the investment process, this could cause the Fund to perform differently or poorly compared to similar funds that do not use such criteria. In addition, the potential benefits to a security in having ESG characteristics may be long term and not visible in performance (or otherwise) for many years, or at all.
- Investors should make their own assessment of the ESG criteria; MSCI's ESG criteria may change over time and the Sub-Investment Manager will manage the Investment Portfolio taking into account any revised methodology; the Fund is not designed to meet any specific ESG criteria as laid out in any particular regulation or guidance and investors need to make their own judgement, where appropriate, on whether the Fund meets any specific criteria.
- As the Fund purchases protection, in a market that has risen or remained flat, the performance of the Fund will be lower than the performance of an unprotected fund following a similar investment policy that does not purchase protection as the cost of the protection will have a negative effect on the Fund's performance.

- Given the Fund's investment policy, there is a risk that there is low exposure to the Investment Portfolio for certain periods with increased exposure to cash. This may lead to the Fund underperforming some markets in which the Investment Portfolio has been invested.
- The use of FDIs involves a higher level of complexity than a direct investment and may multiply the gains or losses of the Fund on a given investment or its investments generally. Additionally, the valuation of certain FDIs may depend on multiple market parameters.
- Due to the reliance on external data providers, there is a possibility that the Investment Portfolio may obtain exposure to the performance of ESG Investment Components that are not in line with the ESG Investment Policy.
- For the avoidance of doubt, an ESG Investment Component (being a UCITS ETF or a UCITS eligible index) may contain underlying securities which do not meet the ESG criteria of the Fund.
- The Fund may use certain investment instruments to reduce the impact of currency or interest rate fluctuations on the NAV. This could result in the Fund losing money in a rising market.
- The Fund's performance may be influenced by movements in currency exchange rates because the Fund may have exposure to assets that are not denominated in the base currency of the Fund.
- Investment in the Fund may be affected by operational risks at the Investment Manager, the Sub-Investment Manager, the Administrator and other service providers to the Fund.
- In certain instances, the directors of the Company may temporarily suspend trading in Fund shares and this may affect your ability to buy or sell shares.
- The Fund will be exposed to the risk of default of the parties with which it transacts. For example, the entity with whom the Fund enters into derivatives may become unable to meet its financial obligations under the contract. Additionally, as Morgan Stanley & Co. International plc or Morgan Stanley Europe SE acts as the FDI counterparty of the Fund and provides the undertaking, if Morgan Stanley & Co. International plc or Morgan Stanley Europe SE became insolvent, the capital protection obtained through the FDI and the undertaking might fail.
- The Fund is subject to a number of risks relating to the insolvency of the Fund's depositary and sub-custodian including the loss of the Fund's assets held in custody due to the lack of segregation or client money protection, or due to the incorrect operation of the custody accounts.
- In the event that the Sub-Investment Management Agreement is terminated, the Fund may be liquidated.


